Call to Order

- James Adams, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 10:50 a.m.

Approval of Minutes

- Tracy Buchanan moved to approve the December 17, 2013 meeting minutes as submitted. Chuck Hart seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Executive Secretary Report

- Ms. Youst informed the Board that renewals were mailed on December 5, 2013.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that she attended testing for the new e-License 2.0 system in mid-January.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that she met with the Board's budget analyst and CSA and determined that the Board will have to go to the Controlling Board and ask for an increase in appropriation authority for both FY14 and FY15. This increase is needed to cover unexpected hearing costs and the higher costs associated with the online version of the examination. The request is revenue neutral.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that they would be having a rules hearing at the March 26, 2014 meeting and would also be reviewing new rules for military personnel in accordance with House Bill 98 (130th General Assembly).
- The Board will be giving the first examination of 2014 on February 20 in Pickerington.
- The formal written reports are attached to the minutes for reference.

Assistant Attorney General Report

- Scott Myers informed the Board that we would be having a hearing at the March 26, 2014 meeting and asked that everyone confirm their availability and attendance with Stephanie Youst as soon as possible to ensure there were no issues with having a quorum.
- Scott Myers informed the Board that we will no longer be using a script for affidavit hearings. These hearings will be conducted as part of adjudication on the Board's agenda. We used a script for the first one so everyone was able to get a good feel for the process.

Adjudication


