





### Call to Order

- Tracy Buchanan, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 11:10 a.m.

### Approval of Minutes

- James Adams moved to approve the May 18, 2016 meeting minutes as submitted. Charles Patterson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

### Executive Secretary Report

- Ms. Youst informed the Board that she will be giving a presentation at the Southeast Fall Ohio Environmental Health Association meeting in September 2016.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that renewals were sent out, via email, to the licensees with an expiration date of 7/31/2016. This renewal seems to be going more smoothly for individuals renewing. This could be due to the portal redesign or the licensees' familiarization with the portal.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that at this time there has not been any movement on House Bill 213, which would require the Board to move to a biennial renewal process.
- The formal written reports are attached to the minutes for reference.

### Assistant Attorney General Report

- The Board asked Scott Myers to discuss what should happen when an individual submits an incomplete application.
  - Mr. Myers indicated that the individual should be notified, in writing, that the application is incomplete and given a date by which all missing material must be submitted.
  - This was in regard to an application for Tru Davis that the Board was reviewing that was incomplete. The application submitted by Ms. Davis was lacking a license verification from Texas. Ms. Davis was notified via email that her application was incomplete and was given a date that the material was to be provided by or her application would be closed.
  - Mr. Myers instructed the Board to send Ms. Davis a new letter indicating that she needed to submit an official verification from Texas, information on her work experience and a copy of her examination score from NEHA or PES if she has already taken the exam.
  - Until Ms. Davis submits the information the Board will not be able to determine if Ms. Davis should apply as an RS or should be allowed to continue on as an SIT applicant.

### Adjudication

#### Public Rules Hearing

- The Board held a public rules hearing convening at 11:34 am regarding rules 4736-16-03 and 4736-16-04 of the Ohio Administrative Code. The hearing concluded at 11:39 am.

## Old Business

### Rule Review & Recommendations

- Ms. Youst informed the Board that three of the proposed rules that were to be filed were submitted to CSI for review and were not filed as part of the most recent packets of rules. Once the recommendations are received from CSI, Ms. Youst will move forward with filing the rules in accordance with rule filing policies.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that it is time to begin thinking about the rules that are up for review in 2017. She will prepare a listing for the Board to review at the September 14, 2016 meeting.

### NEHA Examination Passing Score

- The Board discussed the NEHA examination passing score.
  - Mr. Krinn is in favor of changing the examination score from the current 70% equivalent (657) to the NEHA required passing score, which is currently 650.
  - Dr. Hart is in favor of changing the examination score because it is confusing to the licensees, particularly when they pass the examination according to the NEHA standard, but fail by the Ohio standard. By moving to one score, it would create less confusion.
  - Mr. Phillips is not in favor of changing the examination score to be consistent with NEHA. He does not believe we should lower the standard we have created in Ohio. He also questioned how this became the "national standard". His point is that this is the only national examination available and that does not simply make it a national standard that we should accept, especially since we are afforded the opportunity to set our own passing standard.
  - Mr. Adams is in favor of changing the examination score because he thinks that NEHA has researched the examination and come up with a valid and fair way to score the examination and used a sound methodology when doing so. Regardless of the passing point we select, we will always have individuals on the cusp, who fail and are not happy with the Board.
  - Mr. Myers suggested that the Board draft language consistent with a motion to be reviewed at the September 14, 2016 Board meeting.

**Action:** Charles Patterson moves to direct the Executive Secretary to draft language regarding the examination score consistent with the discussion held at the meeting today, July 27, 2016. Keith Krinn seconded the motion. James Adams, Tracy Buchanan, Charles Hart, Keith Krinn and Charles Patterson voted in favor of the motion. Gene Phillips voted against the motion. The motion passed with a 5:1 vote.

## New Business

- The Board discussed the committee meetings held prior to all regularly scheduled Board meetings. Due to the fact that the committees have been having issues with their material review as of late, it was recommended that all members arrive to begin their committee meetings at 9:30 am on meeting days. This will help prevent the meeting from beginning late.






