

### Call to Order

Richard Setty, Secretary, called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m.

### Approval of Minutes

Gary Silverman moved to approve the March 16, 2011 meeting minutes as submitted. Gene Phillips seconded the motion. The motion carried.

### Committee Reports

The Professional Committee reported that James Adams gave a short presentation on the Board during the environmental health director's session at the Spring Ohio Environmental Health Association Conference. Laura Kramer Kuns also spoke briefly to the SIT examination preparation class regarding how the Board operates and professional responsibility. Tracy Buchanan is planning to give a presentation similar to Mr. Adam's at the OEHA Southwest Fall District Conference.

### Executive Secretary Report

- Ms. Youst informed the Board that she testified in the Ohio House of Representatives on March 24, 2011 and in the Ohio Senate May 4, 2011 regarding the Board's FY2012-2013 budget request.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that the biennial audit began April 29, 2011 and at the time of the Board meeting the audit was still in process. A final audit report will be emailed to all Board members when the Auditor's office is finished auditing fiscal years 2010 and 2011.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that she proctored the examination for 18 candidates on May 4, 2011.
- The formal written and budgetary reports are attached to the minutes for reference.

### Assistant Attorney General Report

- Scott Myers had no formal report for the Board.

### Adjudication

- Laura Kramer Kuns recommended that the Board open an investigation into Andrew Porter. This recommendation will be forwarded to the investigative committee for further review and validation.

**Action:** Gary Silverman moved to deny Debra Walton's application for sanitarian in training registration for failure to meet the minimum educational requirements. Gene Phillips seconded the motion. The motion carried.

**Action:** Gary Silverman moved to deny Emily Bruckmann's application for sanitarian in training registration for failure to meet the minimum educational requirements. Gene Phillips seconded the motion. The motion carried.

**Action:** Laura Kramer Kuns moved to adopt the proposed counts set forth in the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing and find that Mary C. Burns was in violation of Chapter 4736.15 of the Ohio Revised Code. Tracy Buchanan seconded the motion. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

**Action:** Laura Kramer Kuns moved to suspend the registration of Mary C. Burns for a period of thirty (30) days effective immediately upon receipt of the Board order. Gene Phillips seconded the motion. Thereafter, the Chair called for discussion on the motion which is summarized below:

- Ms. Burns admitted to practicing without a registration during her testimony and she also submitted a notarized statement as part of her reinstatement application stating that she had been working since August 1, 2010 without being registered.
- The Board was concerned that Ms. Burns has been a registered sanitarian for approximately 30 years.
- The Board also discussed that, according to Ms. Burns testimony, working without a registration seems to be a common accepted practice at her place of employment. This was troubling to the Board members.
- The Board discussed how terms used when referring to continuing education course review and approval can be misconstrued and advised the Executive Secretary to no longer tell registrants that a course is eligible for Board review.
- The Board members discussed that, even though Ms. Burns may have misinterpreted how the continuing education she submitted would be reviewed, she was notified in August 2010 of her continuing education deficiency and she did not rectify the situation until November 2010.
- The Board members discussed why and how to notify Ms. Burns employer of her sanction and the Board directed the Executive Secretary to send a letter informing the Health Commission and Environmental Health Director of Ms. Burns sanction.

The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Ms. Burns will be notified by certified mail of the Board's decision.

#### **New Business**

##### **2012 Rule Review**

- The Executive Secretary submitted a list of rules to the Board that are up for review in the coming year. The full list is attached to the minutes for reference.
- Ms. Youst recommended that the Board make a change to rule 4736-9-01 of the Ohio Administrative Code. This will also be a recommendation from the Auditor of State's office.
- The recommended change would be to revise or remove 4736-9-01(A)(8) and 4736-9-01(B)(8).
- The Board tabled any further discussion of the rules until the July 27, 2011 Board meeting.
