

Dear Ms. Youst:

Last October, our Office sent your agency a letter regarding how budget decisions in H.B. 1 and existing state law necessitated changes in both the frequency of your audit and how the costs of your audit would be paid. Neither of these changes was sought by the Auditor of State. In order to eliminate the need for a change in audit frequency and to adapt to the budget decisions in H.B. 1, this Office developed an amendment that was included in S.B. 155.

On March 31, 2010, Senate Bill 155 was signed into law by the Governor. This bill, which became effective immediately, provides the Auditor of State the flexibility to conduct biennial audits of state agencies and charge those agencies for our services.

In the spring of 2011, our Office will be contacting you to conduct a biennial audit of your agency. The charges for this audit will be directly billed to your agency on a monthly basis. The audit budget will be based on our analysis for an appropriate level of audit coverage. Any assistance you and your staff can provide in promptly responding to audit requests will aid in our mutual goal to conduct a timely, efficient audit.
