### Executive Secretary Report

- Stephanie Youst informed the Board renewal materials for registrants with a July 31, 2009 expiration date were mailed on June 2, 2009. There are 573 registered sanitarians and 79 sanitarians in training up for renewal.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that 37 candidates took the PES examination offered by the Board on May 20, 2009. The examination results memo is attached to the minutes for reference.
- The Executive Secretary informed the Board that budget cuts for the coming biennium are imminent and wanted the Board to be prepared for a possible cut in the number of meetings they hold each year and to be aware that the office will be operating on a very tight budget for the next several years.
- Ms. Youst also informed the Board that as of the meeting she had not received her final approved FY10 and FY11 budget numbers because the budget is still being debated in the Ohio Senate.
- The Executive Secretary also included the proposed meeting and examination dates for the Board to review for discussion and vote at the September 16, 2009 Board meeting.






# Environmental Health Registration Exams By State
