





### Call to Order

Richard Setty, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 10:20 a.m.

### Approval of Minutes

Roger Suppes moved to approve the July 15, 2009 meeting minutes as corrected. Gary Silverman seconded the motion. The motion carried.

### Executive Secretary Report

- The Executive Secretary informed the Board that the agency budget has been cut by \$8,551 for the next two fiscal years.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that the Central Service Agency notified all the Boards and Commissions that they would be moving from the Riffe Center to the Rhodes Office Tower in October 2009.
- The Executive Secretary informed the Board that the renovation plans for the 16<sup>th</sup> floor had been finalized and the Department of Administrative Services would be paying for the agency move. She told the Board that the date to begin construction had not been finalized.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that examination letters and expiration notices were mailed since the last meeting.
  - The Board members discussed the decline in health district hiring and the increased number of layoffs as potential reasons for the decline in the number of registered sanitarians and sanitarians in training.
  - Rick Setty will contact the Ohio Environmental Health Association Professional Development Committee regarding the decline in the number of registrants and the economic climate and how those two are related.
  - As a long term issue, the Board is concerned that there may not be enough registrants to protect the citizens of Ohio.
- The formal written and budgetary reports are attached to the minutes for reference.

### Assistant Attorney General's Report

- Scott Myers had no formal report for the Board.

### New Business

- The Board members asked the Executive Secretary to contact the Governor's office regarding the new appointments to fill the vacancies left by Angela Townsend and David Winfough.
- Rick Setty informed the Board that he contacted the Governor's office regarding his new position as the Health Commissioner for the Salem City Health District. He asked Ms. Youst to mention his change of employment when she contacts the Governor's office regarding the new appointments to the Board.
- The Board instructed the Executive Secretary to review the retention schedules for the agency and determine if any of the schedules should be updated to allow for imaging records and destroying the paper copies.



**Overview of Activities since the July 15, 2009 Meeting**

- Mailed 90 registered sanitarian and 38 sanitarian in training expiration notices on August 3, 2009.
- Administered the PES examination on August 18, 2009 to 26 registrants. The exam score memo is attached.
- Attended the Boards & Commissions Management Group meetings on July 23, 2009 and August 27, 2009.
- Prepared the LSC annual report and the Board annual report.
