Call to Order

- Tracy Buchanan, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 10:35 a.m.

ODH/ODA Pool Inspections

- The Board members were given a copy of a memorandum of understanding between the Ohio Department of Health Bureau of Environmental Health (ODH) and the Ohio Department of Agriculture Amusement Ride Safety Division (ODA).
- The Board members reviewed this memo and inferred that ODA Amusement Ride Safety Division employees are conducting pool inspections as part of the special inspections they are permitted to conduct.
 - Per the ODH/ODA agreement, the Amusement Ride Safety Division has jurisdiction over rides. The question becomes are ODA inspectors practicing environmental health as it is defined in section 4736.01(E) of the Ohio Revised Code.
 - If the ODA inspectors are sampling, testing, reporting of vectors or reporting their observations then it is considered practicing environmental health and they should hold licensure as an RS or SIT. However, section 4736.01 of the Ohio Revised Code does not encompass ODA and pools per se.
- The Board members asked that this topic be placed on the March agenda for further discussion.

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MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
BUREAU OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH
AND
OHIO DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
AMUSEMENT RIDE SAFETY DIVISION

This Agreement is entered into between the Ohio Department of Health, Bureau of Environmental Health, hereinafter called ODH, and the Ohio Department of Agriculture, Amusement Ride Safety Division, hereinafter called ODA.

WHEREAS, ODH has regulatory authority over public special use pools, including approval of plans and construction inspections, pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) chapter 3749, with special use pools defined as a public swimming pool containing flume slides, wave generating equipment, or other special features that necessitate different design and safety requirements and does not include any water slide or wave generating pool at a public amusement area which is licensed and inspected by ODA pursuant to ORC sections 1711.50 and 1711.57; and

WHEREAS, a city health district or a general health district is the authority to license public special use pools pursuant to ORC chapter 3749; and

WHEREAS, ODA has regulatory authority over amusement rides, including permitting and periodic inspections, pursuant to ORC chapter 1711, with amusement rides defined as any mechanical device, aquatic device, or combination of devices that carries or conveys passengers on, along, around, over or through a fixed or restricted course or within a defined area for the purpose of giving its passengers amusement, pleasure, or excitement; and

WHEREAS, ODH regulatory authority over public special use pools and ODA regulatory authority over aquatic devices can be overlapping for such items as, but not limited to, water slides emptying into different types of pools, leisure rivers, and wave pools; and

WHEREAS, ODH and ODA have a mutual interest in the overall benefit and safety of the public in their use of special use pools at a location that may be regulated by both agencies;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree to cooperate and establish a procedure which the two agencies will take on a case-by-case basis when determining which agency or both have jurisdiction over the regulation of a particular facility. This Agreement shall be guided by the following:

1. ODH will have jurisdiction, including plan approval and construction inspections, for public special use pools including the flume slides, wave generating equipment, or other special features, when any indoor or outdoor structure, chamber, or tank contains a body of water intended for swimming, diving, or bathing. Examples:
 - a. Swimming pool with a slide landing area included in the same body of water
 - b. Swimming pool with a leisure river included in the same body of water
 - c. Wave pool where patrons can swim, dive, or bathe except at a public amusement area (see item 4 below)

2. Pursuant to Chapter 3749 of the Revised Code, a city or general health district having jurisdiction over the facilities described above in item 1 shall process an application to operate or maintain a facility described in item 1 and either issue a license to operate or maintain such facilities or otherwise respond regarding the application.
3. ODA will have jurisdiction, including permitting and periodic inspections, for aquatic devices that have an area of water not intended for swimming, diving, or bathing and is a fixed or restricted course within a defined area to carry or convey passengers. Examples:
 - a. Slide with a separate, confined landing area of water that is not included in the same body of water as a pool
 - b. Leisure river that is not included in the same body of water as a pool
4. Furthermore, ODA has jurisdiction, including permitting and periodic inspections, for aquatic devices with a fixed or restricted course within a defined area to carry or convey passengers in a public amusement area. Public amusement area means any place at which one or more water slides or wave generating pools are located that is intended primarily for the operation of amusement rides, games or similar attractions. Campgrounds, municipal parks, hotels, motels, apartment/condominium complexes, athletic clubs, and public swimming pools are not normally considered public amusement areas. Examples of aquatic devices in public amusement areas:
 - a. Wave pool
 - b. Leisure river that is not included in the same body of water as a pool
 - c. Slide with a separate, confined landing area of water that is not included in the same body of water as a pool
 - d. Bodies of water with features to crossover such as bridges, floating footholds or overhead handholds that are not included in the same body of water as a pool
 - e. Playground equipment with water features
5. ODH and a city health district or general health district will have jurisdiction for public swimming pools/spas and special use pools that do not fit the definition of an aquatic device, as described above in item 4, that are located in a public amusement area.
6. Existing facilities that have been deemed as special use pools and aquatic devices located in public amusement areas and those publicly/privately owned not located in public amusement areas that are regulated by either party contrary to this Agreement will be reevaluated. Until both parties agree on jurisdiction, the existing special use pools and aquatic devices will remain licensed or permitted by the party that currently has jurisdiction.
7. To protect and promote the public health and safety ODH and ODA agree to cooperate in cross training of staff for review of plans, construction inspections, permitting procedures and periodic inspections, as appropriate and as time permits with no cost to either party. *ODA also agrees to assist local health districts in Recreational Water Illness & Injury investigations that occur at their permitted facilities.*
8. *Annually during the first week of November the agencies agree to work together to determine jurisdiction of facilities that are under question prior to either agency licensing the entity.*

However, it is possible that both agencies may have jurisdiction over portions of the same facility. In order to provide local health districts with accurate information regarding the regulatory responsibilities, ODH will advise local health districts of facilities where ODA is exercising jurisdiction and therefore the local health district would not have licensing jurisdiction. ODA agrees to assist ODH in this effort by providing ODH with a list of such facilities by February 1st of each year.

9. Either party giving the other 30 day advance, written notice of termination may terminate this Agreement.
10. ODH and ODA agree that in the performance of this Agreement, there will be no discrimination against any person because of race, color, sex, religion, national origin, age, disability, handicap, or any other factor specified in the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, in section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, and in any subsequent legislation pertaining to civil rights.
11. ODH and ODA agree that neither party is responsible for the actions or inactions of the other in the performance of the terms of this Agreement or delay in the carrying out the of the terms of this agreement due to acts of God, wars, riots, strikes, or other causes beyond the control of the parties.
12. All the terms and conditions of this Agreement are embodied herein. No other terms and conditions will be considered a part of this agreement unless expressly agreed upon in writing and signed by both parties.
13. This Agreement cannot be assigned by either party.
