





Call to Order

Linda Aller, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

Approval of Minutes

James Adams moved to approve the December 7, 2011 meeting minutes as submitted. Richard Setty seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Committee Reports

Continuing Education Committee

- The members of the Continuing Education Committee discussed the lack of form completion by individuals requesting continuing education credit with the Board.
 - The Committee requested that Stephanie Youst return any incomplete forms that are submitted from individuals or agencies seeking credit for continuing education coursework.
 - The Committee also requested that Ms. Youst revise the continuing education forms (CE2, CE3 and CE4) and submit the revisions to the Committee for comment before they are presented to the Board.
 - The Committee recommended that effective August 1, 2012, the new forms become mandatory and any incomplete or old forms that are submitted will be returned and the individuals or agencies seeking credit will be required to use the new forms.

Action: James Adams moved to authorize Stephanie Youst to return applications that are incomplete or not correctly completed effective August 1, 2012. Tracy Buchanan seconded the motion. The motion carried.

- The members of the Continuing Education Committee discussed the submittal of rosters from training agencies.
 - Stephanie Youst informed the Board that most agencies do send their rosters into the Board in a timely manner; however, there are several agencies that never send the required documents into the Board.
 - The Board members recommended keeping a tickler file to track who does not comply with rule 4736-11-07 of the Ohio Revised Code.
 - The Board also asked that Ms. Youst inform the Board if there is a trend in agencies that are not submitting their information so action can be taken on their status as a training agency.

Executive Secretary Report

- Stephanie Youst informed the Board that things in the office had been busy and renewals were coming in at a steady pace for processing since the renewal deadline was nearing.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that she mailed 23 training agency expiration notices on January 3, 2012.
- Ms. Youst gave the Board the exam results from the August 30, 2011 and December 15, 2011 exams.
- The formal written reports are attached to the minutes for reference.

Assistant Attorney General Report

- Scott Myers informed the Board that Dallas Hettinger has appealed the Board's decision on the hearing held in December 2011 with the Ross County Court of Common Pleas.
 - Mr. Myers informed the Board that the Court's job is to review the Board's decision and the information presented at the hearing and in the appeal and determines who is at fault for Mr. Hettinger failing to renew his registration in a timely manner.
 - Mr. Myers informed the Board that the appeal process could take anywhere from 2 months to 2 years, depending on the caseload of the Court. Mr. Myers expects a ruling on the appeal in approximately 6 months.
- Since working without registration seems to be a recurring issue, Mr. Myers suggested that the Board think about how they want to handle this issue in the future.

New Business

- The Board reviewed a draft letter that will be submitted for inclusion in the Ohio Environmental Health Association Journal where the Board will have a standing column.
 - James Adams suggested putting an additional paragraph in the draft letter dealing with training agencies submitting their rosters in a timely manner.
 - Tracy Buchanan volunteered to write future columns.



News from the R. S. Board

This is the inaugural piece in a new column from the State Board of Sanitarian Registration (Board) that will serve as a news source for information pertaining to matters of the Board. New information, policy changes and other noteworthy information will be posted in this column.

At the December 7, 2011 Sanitarian Registration Board Meeting, the Board made a decision regarding CE4 applications that will impact all future applications submitted for continuing education credit. **In accordance with rule 4736-11-06(A) of the Ohio Administrative Code all CE-4 applications (application for pre-approval of a course or program offered by an approved training agency) must be submitted at least 30 days prior to the date the course is being presented.**

Any application submitted fewer than 30 days prior to the date the course is being given will be denied and the applicants attending the course will need to submit CE-2 applications if they would like to obtain continuing education credit for that particular course. This change will take effect immediately. Should you have any questions regarding this change, please feel free to contact Stephanie Youst at stephanie.youst@exchagne.state.oh.us or (614) 466-1772.

All training agencies approved by the R. S Board were notified of this change via letter in mid-December. When attending a course that is said to be "pre-approved", it would be wise to double check this fact on the R.S. Board website. Course approvals are posted on the website following each Board meeting and as such, it might be helpful to check the website before you attend to see if in fact the course has been pre-approved. When in doubt, call the R.S. Board office and ask questions. A little legwork ahead of time could save a lot of headache after the fact.
