





Old Business

2016 Rules Review & Recommendation

- This item was tabled until the May 18, 2016 meeting.

NEHA Examination Passing Score

- Keith Krinn expressed his concern regarding the fact that Ohio has a higher passing standard than what is accepted by NEHA on the examination for registration as a sanitarian.
- Mr. Krinn informed the Board that it was his belief that Ohio was the only state using the NEHA examination that had a passing rate different than what was the NEHA accepted passing rate.
- The Board is hoping that data from the study Ms. Holbrook is doing as part of her graduate research may help shed some light on this topic.
 - Her results will be available after her graduation date in May 2016.
- This item will be revisited at a later date when the full Board is present.

Reciprocity vs. Registration in Ohio

- Keith Krinn asked why we do not accept/extend reciprocity since it is stated in the Ohio Revised code that the Board "may" accept a license via reciprocity.
- Scott Myers explained to Mr. Krinn and the rest of the Board that we state in the Ohio Revised Code that we "may" accept a reciprocal license; however what this means is that our education, work experience requirement and exam/test standards are the same as the state we are accepting the license from. To date, this has not been the case with any state.
- Mr. Myers explained that if the licensure requirements vary from state to state, you do not enter into a compact agreement, otherwise known as reciprocity, with that state.
- This item will be revisited at a later date when the full Board is present.

1: **Mary Helen Smith:** Ms. Smith would like to ask the Board if an SIT engaged in full time practice administering, conducting inspections, making evaluations and implementing enforcement activities of a semi-public wastewater program within the confines of a general health district under the supervision of an RS would be considered as "practicing environmental health". **Action:** The Board informed Ms. Smith that in her letter, R.C. 4736.01(E) defines the practice of environmental health which practice requires licensure in Ohio. It would appear from her description that by inspecting, evaluating and engaging in enforcement activities, within the context of a wastewater system, that the person described falls within the parameters of R.C. 4736.01(E). This conclusion is based solely on her representations and does not take into account other factors that may or

may not exist. Generally, hours engaged in activities requiring licensure would be applicable when the sanitarian in training applies for advancement to registered sanitarian. This conclusion likewise could be altered if there are facts or circumstance unknown to the Board. The Board is not clear on what other information Ms. Smith is seeking with regard to the use of a sanitarian in training in a semi-public commercial wastewater program. If Ms. Smith would like to provide additional clarifying information, the Board will be happy to review additional correspondence at the May 18, 2016 meeting and provide supplementary feedback.

2: John Bibish: Mr. Bibish would like to thank the Executive Secretary for her assistance with the application process for his daughter in law. Acton: The Board thanks Mr. Bibish for his comments regarding the Executive Secretary.

3: Gail Livecchia: Ms. Livecchia would like to share some suggestions with the Board regarding continuing education and disaster preparedness. Acton: The Board thanks Ms. Livecchia for her comments and suggestions.

4: Marcia Dreiseidel: Ms. Dreiseidel would like to ask the Board to clarify if an individual is hired as an environmental health tech doing sewage system assessments and inspections and water sampled would that work experience qualify toward their advancement since they are not working as an SIT. Acton: The Board reviewed Ms. Dreiseidel's inquiry and determined that the internal classification of the individual is irrelevant. What should be considered are the duties the individual in the position will be performing and the percentage of time they will be performing those duties. The Board is not clear on what other information Ms. Dreiseidel is seeking with regard to the use of a sanitarian in training in her environmental health tech position. If she would like to provide additional clarifying information, the Board will be happy to review her correspondence at the May 18, 2016 meeting and provide further feedback.

The applicant shall provide sufficient information so that the Board can make a determination if the course is to be approved in accordance with this paragraph.

In reviewing your application for registered sanitarian, the Board found evidence showing that you completed only 29 of the required 30 semester hours of approved educational coursework, thereby leaving your educational coursework deficient by 1 semester hour.



Thank you for following up with Ms. Mata. I am a bit confused when we say we don't have reciprocity agreements with any other state yet the law says we "may"...

The state law says:

4736.14 Reciprocity.

The state board of sanitarian registration may, upon application and proof of valid registration, issue a certificate of registration to any person who is or has been registered as sanitarian by any other state, if the requirements of that state at the time of such registration are determined by the board to be at least equivalent to the requirements of this chapter.

(2001 H 94, 09-05-2001; 1987 H 129, 07-20-1987; H 137)


So I'm wondering if the policy was adapted by a previous board back in time and wondering why if the law speaks to it and allows it. Also, what's the difference between "reciprocity" and "by endorsement". As I recall, I personally was granted reciprocity for my Michigan RS in 2003 which at the time was using the PES exam and had a more stringent experience requirement of three years. I also had and still maintain the NEHA RS and took the NEHA test as well.

Perhaps we can discuss and it sort of dovetails into a discussion about debating accepting the NEHA passing score or not we talked about earlier. I'm not advocating we change the reciprocity policy or the passing score, just that we have a healthy discussion about it next meeting.

At this time Ohio does not have a reciprocity agreement with any other state. You are welcome to apply for registration as an RS via the licensure portal at: https://elicense.ohio.gov/BIZC_HomeUnauth. In order to be eligible to hold registration as an RS in Ohio you must have at least 2 years full time experience in the practice of environmental health, as defined by Chapter 4736.01(E) of the Ohio Revised Code, passage of the NEHA or PES examination with a minimum score of 70% or its equivalent, and the completion of at least 45 quarter hours or 30 semester hours of biology, chemistry, physics, geology, math and statistics.

Along with the completed online application you will need to submit an official copy of your college/university transcripts to the Board office at the address listed below. You will need to provide a verification of licensure from any state in which you currently hold or have ever held a license, and you will need to complete the attached forms. You will also need to provide a breakdown of your work experience, duties and responsibilities. This should include the duties you performed while employed in environmental health and the percentage of time you devoted to each of these activities on a weekly basis.

The state law says:

4736.14 Reciprocity.

The state board of sanitarian registration may, upon application and proof of valid registration, issue a certificate of registration to any person who is or has been registered as sanitarian by any other state, if the requirements of that state at the time of such registration are determined by the board to be at least equivalent to the requirements of this chapter.

(2001 H 94, 09-05-2001; 1987 H 129, 07-20-1987; H 137)

So then the defining thing is the California REHS "equivalent" to the Ohio RS? I know California administers its own written examination and as to my knowledge does not use the NEHA exam, unless things have changed out there. Now if you happened to have taken and passed the NEHA exam, then you're probably golden. There is also a caveat to that however. Ohio requires a slightly higher score than NEHA requires. Ohio requires a raw score of 70% and the NEHA bar is slightly lower depending on a number of variables. I believe the passing score most recently was 64% and there a few unfortunates that get caught in the issue with say a raw score of 69%. It's rare but does happen.

Anyway, start with making an application with the RS board and talk to Stephanie Youst, the board's executive secretary.

This letter is in response to your correspondence regarding the use of a sanitarian in training in a semi-public commercial wastewater program.

As you reference in your letter, R.C. 4736.01(E) defines the practice of environmental health which practice requires licensure in Ohio. It would appear from your description that by inspecting, evaluating and engaging in enforcement activities, within the context of a wastewater system, that the person you describe falls within the parameters of R.C. 4736.01(E). This conclusion is based solely on your representations and does not take into account other factors that may or may not exist. Generally, hours engaged in activities requiring licensure would be applicable when the sanitarian in training applies for advancement to registered sanitarian. This conclusion likewise could be altered if there are facts or circumstance unknown to the Board.

The Board is not clear on what other information you are seeking with regard to the use of a sanitarian in training in your semi-public commercial wastewater program. If you wish to provide additional clarifying information, the Board will be happy to review your correspondence at the May 18, 2016 meeting and provide additional feedback.

Dear Sanitarian Registration Board Members:

Please confirm whether a sanitarian-in-training, engaged full-time to administer, conduct inspections, make evaluations and implement enforcement activities of a semi-public wastewater program within a general health district under the supervision of a registered sanitarian can be considered as practicing environmental public health.


Please note, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 4736.01(E) defines the "practice of environmental health" as consultation, instruction, investigation, inspection, or evaluation by an employee of... a general health district requiring specialized knowledge, training, and experience in the field of environmental health science, with the primary purpose of improving or conducting administration or enforcement. ORC Chapter 4736 also states, "The state board of sanitarian registration may further define environmental health science in relation to specific functions in the practice of environmental health...".

Although, the semi-public commercial wastewater program does not specifically fall within the statute as required programs for sanitarian registration, we believe that these activities can be construed to meet the definition of sanitarian as defined in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 4736-1-01(M), "a person who performs, for compensation, educational, investigational, technical, or administrative duties requiring specialized knowledge and skills in the field of environmental health science."

It is noted that the Sanitarian Registration Board's Policies & Procedures Manual addresses situations when credit can be given for alternate public health practice experience. In particular, Policy #4736-30, *Environmental Health Experience*, Item 11 allows credit for Semi-public Sewage Operators. Therefore, sanitarian-in-training performing semi-public wastewater inspections may be acceptable if the primary purpose is environmental health sciences (web accessed March 2, 2016, <http://sanitarian.ohio.gov/pdfs/PoliciesProcedures.pdf>).

Is there a way to make a formal suggestion for hours?

For example, I just took the CPO course. I'll take one of the ones below, but if I take both, they are wasted hours. There are other courses that have the same type of sequencing, and it's better to take them one after another. It would be nice if 8 hours could be carried over to the next year. That still leaves the majority of hours in the following year, but it allows people to take sequence courses and get the most out of them.

That is just my suggestion. But, I'd like the board to consider it. Even if it is limited to sequence courses such as the NRA food safety courses and CPO. Various organizations might also offer a price break if one registered for all the courses. And, not all courses are offered throughout the summer, so that one could play with the date. The one I took this week was the only time it is offered close to me. On paper, Morristown looks close, but an hour or more with rush hour traffic, because 80 is clogged with traffic into NYC. Also, if one takes a language, part one is fall semester, then part 2 in spring. Again, I'm not saying earn 36 in one year. But, increase the amount to take advantage of sequence courses, or a rarely offered course or speaker.

My plan is to take the inspector course.

Also, as something to pass on... I'm a professional student. When there is a test, there are always practice tests. I googled, and there are 2 CPO tests on-line. My test was almost identical to the one on-line. I mentioned it to the instructor, who was unaware there were practice exams....

Something else I think should be discussed, if it hasn't been... in the event of a statewide disaster, is there a plan for licensing sanitarians from other states if there would be a need to ask for help? If not, I'd even be willing to drive out, and share my experiences with Sandy. For example, making a list of gas stations and restaurants with generators. I remember in the 2004 ice storm, Kroger brought a semi that was a generator for the store in Johnstown. During Hurricane Irene, Cracker Barrel brought one in. But, gas was a huge issue in NJ. We actually went to rationing. One thing the state discovered was that they didn't know which stations had generators. So, some stations had gas, but no way to pump it. Others had power, but no gas. So, a list of generators would be beneficial.

And, one other thought. I wrote a guest article for the NY History Blog. A new trend with historical societies and museums is to offer food programs. Generally, period food. I was at a conference, where one group, a state site no less, prepared a meal for 70 people in the home kitchen of one of the employees. They then transported it in their cars, and finished it off at the site. Where to even start... but, it might be worth it to mention it as a heads up for health departments.

Just my thoughts.
