It's just that easy! It is the hope of the Board that by changing the form and making it easier to use will result in the receipt of CE-2 requests that are completed in their entirety. Too often the Board receives forms with no applicable subject matter, no signature and in some instances, no program description. Remember – the form has to be filled out in its entirety to be considered complete. So please, take the time to fill out your CE-2 form with the same thought and attention to detail that you would give an inspection report or a letter to a regulated entity as this too displays your level of professionalism. Thanks for the response. Based on what I read below, I feel like the system is flawed. RS hours are an annual requirement, although if I want to be "safe" all of the training that I want to do that needs approval has to be completed before May, which makes the annual requirement a 9-month requirement. This not only makes getting my RS hours more difficult and potentially results in me taking a pre-approved course that may not have a significant benefit to what I actually do at my job, but it discourages any additional training between May 4 and July 31. I understand that this may be something that is out of your control, but I feel it is important to provide you with my perspective, so it can potentially be passed on. I also understand that there needs to be some expectation of prioritization on the part of registered sanitarians to take this requirement seriously and get their hours completed, however I think that this should be able to be completed in such a manner that it does not take away from them carrying out their actual jobs. It should be recognized by the board that at some point, the more difficult it is to maintain this certification, the less incentive people have to actually maintain it in the event that their jobs do not specifically require it.

you still have 14.25 hours which means you need an additional 3.75 hours to be eligible to renew your registration. The "safe" date for CE submittal is May 4, which is for the May 9 meeting. We have a Board meeting scheduled on July 25 as well, but that will be cutting it awfully close.

I would recommend that you consider taking one of the pre-approved FEMA courses offered. The list of courses is on the website under the Important News link on the left side of the webpage. Evan -

The Board reviewed your correspondence at the May 9, 2012 and wanted to clarify the three pronged approach for becoming a registered sanitarian in the State of Ohio.

With regard to the educational requirements necessary to become a registered sanitarian, the Ohio Revised Code states the following:

4736.08 Application for registration.

An application for registration as a sanitarian shall be made to the state board of sanitarian registration on a form prescribed by the board and accompanied by the application fee prescribed in section 4736.12 of the Revised Code. The board shall register an applicant if the applicant meets the requirements of section 4736.16 of the Revised Code, or is of good moral character, passes an examination conducted by the board in accordance with section 4736.09 of the Revised Code, and meets the education and experience requirements of division (A), (B) or (C) of this section:

- (A) Graduated from an accredited college or university with at least a baccalaureate degree, including at least forty-five quarter units or thirty semester units of science courses approved by the board; and completed at least two years of full-time employment as a sanitarian;
- (B) Graduated from an accredited college or university with at least a baccalaureate degree, completed a major in environmental health science which included an internship program approved by the board; and completed at least one year of full-time employment as a sanitarian;
- (C) Graduated from an accredited college or university with a degree higher than a baccalaureate degree, including at least forty-five quarter units or thirty semester units of science courses approved by the board; and completed at least one year of full-time employment as a sanitarian.

(1995 H 263, 11-21-1995; 1977 H 137)

As you can see from this portion of the law the General Assembly determined that minimum educational requirements were essential, but also recognized the importance of work experience. They further required that, to be eligible for registration, an applicant must have at least two years full time work experience in environmental health or one year of full time work experience in environmental health with the completion of an advanced degree.

The final qualification for becoming a registered sanitarian is that the applicant must take and pass a national examination that includes applicable subjects in the field of environmental health. The Ohio Revised Code states,

4736.09 Written examination.

Examinations required by section 4736.08 of the Revised Code shall be conducted not less than once each calendar year at such times and places as the state board of sanitarian registration prescribes. Such examinations shall be written and shall include applicable subjects in the field of environmental health science and such other subjects as the board may prescribe. The examination shall be objective and practical. Any

examination papers shall not disclose the name of the applicant, but shall be identified by a number assigned by the secretary of the board. The preparation of the examination shall be the responsibility of the board; however, the board may use material prepared by recognized examination agencies.

No person shall be registered if he fails to meet the minimum grade requirements for the examination specified by the board. An applicant who fails to meet such minimum grade requirements in his first examination may be reexamined at any time and place specified by the board, upon resubmission of his application and payment of the fee prescribed in section 4736.12 of the Revised Code.

(1977 H 137, 08-15-1977)

The Ohio Administrative Code further requires that once an individual is registered, a sanitarian must annually demonstrate that he/she has completed 18 hours of Board approved continuing education applicable to the field of environmental health.

4736-11-03 Hours of continuing education required.

- (A) Registrants must complete eighteen clock hours of approved continuing education courses each year to be eligible to apply for renewal of their certificate.
- (B) The board may waive continuing education hours in cases of a registrant's certified illness or disability which prevents the attendance at any qualified educational seminars during the twelve months immediately preceding the annual certificate of registration renewal date. Continuing education waivers will be determined on a case by case basis. Waivers shall not be granted for a period in excess of three consecutive renewal periods.

4736-11-04 Types of continuing education courses.

A course of study or program of instruction offered to meet the continuing education requirements for annual renewal of the certificate of registration shall be board approved and in the following subject areas:

- (A) Diseases and injuries caused by environmental factors and the applicable prevention techniques.
- (B) Administrative law and process.
- (C) The utilization of resources in the collection, arrangement, and interpretation of data.
- (D) Environmental health administration.
- (E) New or substantially revised environmental health laws, rules and process.
- (F) Functional fields of environmental health to include air quality, food quality and protection, hazardous and toxic substances, consumer product safety, housing, institutional health and safety, community noise control, radiation protection, bioterrorism, recreational facilities, solid, infectious and liquid waste management, vector control, drinking water quality, milk sanitation, rabies control, land use and occupational health and safety.
- (G) Environmental health planning or emergency preparedness.
- (H) Communication skills.
- (I) Organization or program management courses.
- (J) Computer skills development and functional utilization.

In order to be eligible to become a registered SIT in Ohio, you must have at least a bachelor's degree and a minimum of 45 quarter hours or 30 semester hours in science (Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics), math, and/or statistics. Those hours must appear on your official college/university transcript. Work experience does not count toward the minimum educational hours requirement. For any course that is not labeled as a hard science I recommend that the candidate submit the course description/syllabus for the Board to review. The Board is very strict on the educational hours requirement so I would recommend taking a look at your transcripts before you apply.

I am inquiring on the results from the RS Examination held in March 2012. I understand from a co-worker who also took the exam in March that you have yet to receive the results. As you can imagine, this is very frustrating for the 30 of us who are waiting. Could you please explain the process to me, I think it would help me better understand why this lengthy amount of time is necessary. I cannot see how it takes over four weeks for 30 scantrons to be read. Unless they are being graded by hand, it really should only take a day or two at maximum. I understand (though don't know the reasoning) that they get sent out of state to be graded, but that still doesn't explain the vast time lapse. Please know that I am in no way blaming you, but poor customer service reflects negatively on the board. I am approaching a situation where I have taken the exam more than once and need to know whether I have passed in order to file for an SIT renewal (and extension because this is my third year) or file for an RS application. It is just very stressful that after all of the work that has gone into preparing for this difficult exam, I must now wait almost 6 weeks just to find out whether I have to go through it all again. I'm very sorry for the inconvenience this email causes, but I need to bring the frustration to your attention so that perhaps appropriate changes can be made to this process for future sanitarians.
