NEWS from the RS BOARD

With the upcoming changes in the manufactured home park (MHP) program, the RS Board has received numerous inquiries regarding the need or requirement for an RS to conduct inspections of MHPs. As you are probably aware, under the new program inspections of MHP's can be conducted by outside or third party individuals. Is this true? Why doesn't this task require an RS? At the September RS Board meeting, these questions were discussed at length and, as usual, there is always more to the story.

First, everyone needs to be aware of the fact that at least until December 31st or until such time as new rules are enacted, MHP's will continue to be inspected by local health department staff. According to Gene Phillips, Director of Environmental Services at ODH and RS Board member, the issue of requiring an RS was never discussed during the program negotiations with the MHP Commission. Keep in mind that there were many entities at the table including ODH, OEHA and AOHC and apparently no one thought to mention this issue. This was, by all accounts, a simple oversight.

Following passage of new MHP rules, local health departments do have the ability to retain the program if they so choose. If not, then it will fall under the purview of the MHP Commission and the entities that they contract with to conduct the park inspections. These inspectors will look for and regulate things such as spacing, electrical issues, out buildings and other "zoning like" issues. Any nuisance conditions encountered will be referred to

the local health departments to investigate and correct. As such, there will still be registered sanitarians in MHPs to some extent.

Unfortunately, the way the current law is written (insert Bill # here) there is nothing that the RS Board can do at this point. Any change to the law at this point would require reopening the bill which, as many of you know, can be a trying experience.

Subject: Comments on Rules

4736-10-01 (C) – There may be extenuating circumstances that prevent an “S.I.T.” from requesting an extension *prior* to the third annual registration renewal. Therefore, this should be considered on a case-by-case basis. 4736-10-01 (E) may be a big reason for this, depending upon when the exam is offered each year, and when the “S.I.T.’s” renewal date is. To that extent, I think 4736-10-01 (E) should be enforced *without exception*.

4736-15-03 (A) and (B) – This seems fair. However, a concern, similar to 4735-10-01 (C) exists. Again, a case-by-case basis should be used to determine if the five-year rule should be enforced. This should be at the discretion of the Sanitarian Registration Board, *with* consideration from the “S.I.T.’s” current supervisor *and* a review of the “S.I.T.’s” work history and performance evaluations.

I have no other comments at this time.

In accordance with Governor Kasich’s Common Sense Initiative, you are receiving this email as an interested party to provide comment on proposed changes to the rules attached to this correspondence.

The Board will review all comments received and will determine whether or not to make changes to the proposed rules based upon the comments received. Final draft proposed rules will then be filed with the Common Sense Initiative Office (CSI). You will receive notification of this filing, along with a Business Impact Analysis that describes the impact to businesses that the proposed rules may have. You will have the opportunity to provide public comment to the CSI Office and the Board regarding any provision of the proposed rules filed with the CSI Office.

Once the CSI Office compiles and reviews all interested party comments, it will provide recommendations to the Board for which the Board must provide a formal response. Once the CSI process is complete, the Board can then proceed to formally filing the rules with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR). These formal proposed rules will sent to you in a separate email once all steps of the CSI process have been completed.

Procedures and information: examination.

- (A) Applicants for registered sanitarian shall pass an examination conducted by the board.
- (1) Information concerning examination procedures is available and may be obtained at the office of the state board of sanitarian registration.
 - (2) Examinations shall be held at least one time each year and at more frequent intervals if the board deems this necessary. The board may limit the number of applicants at any examination to that which may be adequately and prudently accommodated and supervised.
 - (3) Examinations shall be held in central Ohio, and at such other places as may be determined by the board.
 - (4) Applicants for examination must either be registered as sanitarians-in-training or approved to take the examination by the board through submission of an application for registered sanitarian.
 - (5) The board shall charge separate fees for examination, provided that the fees are not in excess of the actual cost to the board of conducting the examinations.
 - (6) Applications for examination must be made on forms prescribed by the board. Each completed application must be accompanied by a check or money order payable in the manner prescribed by the board in the amount of the appropriate fee.
 - (7) An applicant shall be considered scheduled for an examination upon receipt by the board of the application. The examination fee shall not be returned after applicant is scheduled for examination.
 - (8) ~~Applications for examination and the appropriate fee must be received by the board at least thirty five days prior to the examination date.~~
- (B) The board may require an examination for registration as a sanitarian-in-training and shall annually determine whether an examination shall be required.
- (1) If the board requires an examination for registration as a sanitarian-in-training, the following procedures shall apply:
 - (2) Information concerning examination procedures will be available and may be

Type of examination.

The board shall provide a written examination which is objective and practical and meets the requirements of section 4736.09 of the Revised Code.

4736-10-01

Sanitarian-in-training extension request.

- (A) A sanitarian-in-training shall apply for registration as a sanitarian within three years of registration as a sanitarian-in-training.

The board may extend the registration of any sanitarian-in-training who furnishes, in writing, sufficient cause for not applying for registration as a sanitarian within the three year period.

- (B) Sufficient cause for extending sanitarian-in-training registration will be determined by the board on a case by case basis. Sufficient cause for extension shall include but is not limited to:

(1) The sanitarian-in-training has taken the registration examination at least once, or;

(2) The sanitarian-in-training has competently performed for compensation, educational, investigational, technical or administrative duties in the field of environmental health science on or before the date of the extension request.

- (C) A sanitarian-in-training must be granted an extension of sanitarian-in-training certification prior to the issuance of the third annual registration renewal. Certificates of registration expire annually and become invalid on that date unless renewed pursuant to section 4736.11 of the Revised Code.

- (D) The extension request shall be written, and shall include:

(1) An explanation of why the requestor has not applied for registered sanitarian status.

(2) A listing of full-time experience from the date the sanitarian-in-training certificate was granted.

(3) The number of times the requestor has taken the registration examination.

- (E) A sanitarian-in-training who fails the registration examination on three or more occasions may be required, as part of the application process to retake the examination, to submit and show evidence of a study plan toward passing the registration examination, and/or meet such other requirements as may be imposed by the board.

Use of registered sanitarian and sanitarian-in-training designation.

- (A) The recipients of a certificate of registered sanitarian may use the appropriate registration designation following their name. The abbreviation "R.S." may be used in place of the words "Registered Sanitarian."

- (B) The recipients of a certificate of sanitarian-in-training may use the appropriate registration designation following their name. The abbreviation "S.I.T." may be used in place of the words "Sanitarian-in-Training."

Practice limitation for sanitarian-in-training.

- (A) A sanitarian-in-training may engage in the practice of environmental health for a period not to exceed five years, provided the sanitarian-in-training is supervised by a registered sanitarian.

- (B) The five-year time limitation commences once the sanitarian-in-training begins to engage in the practice of environmental health full-time, part-time, or part-of-the-year and concludes five years from that date unless the sanitarian-in-training ceases to engage in the practice of environmental health during an entire renewal period.
