



Call to Order

- Tracy Buchanan, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 11:45 a.m.

Approval of Minutes

- James Adams moved to approve the July 29, 2015 meeting minutes as corrected. Gene Phillips seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Committee Reports

- Tracy Buchanan informed the Board that she wrote an article for the OEHA journal regarding the changes to the licensure system. It was put into the online version of the journal and will be in the hard copy version when it is printed.

Executive Secretary Report

- Ms. Youst informed the members of the Board that she, in collaboration with Tracy Buchanan, had developed a Board member handbook. A copy was given to each of the Board members for their reference.
 - Items in the handbook include: a brief history of the Board, the role of a Board member, information on Board meetings and the Open Meetings Act, information related to Public Records laws, information on the Ohio Ethics Commission and financial disclosure requirements, the licensure and renewal processes, the discipline and complaint process and the rule making process.
- Ms. Youst informed the Board that the new licensing system went live on August 3, 2015.
 - Since the go-live date, there has been a steady increase in the number of phone calls to the Board office
 - These calls are from licensees who are having issues accessing and/or using the new system. The typical call lasts, on average, 15 minutes.
 - Ms. Youst informed the Board that she has also fielded calls from individuals who are not happy with the change due to a variety of reasons.
 - She informed the Board that she has handled all of the calls and expects the volume to decrease after the initial wave of individuals registering for the first time on the portal is over.
 - Prior to the first renewal notices being emailed to RS's, Ms. Youst will email a second notification to individuals urging them to register their profile on the portal to ensure they are notified of the upcoming renewal. She expects to email this second notification during the last week of September 2015.
 - Ms. Youst informed the Board that the first set of notices to individuals renewing on the new system will be emailed on November 1, 2015.
- The formal written reports are attached to the minutes for reference.

Assistant Attorney General Report

- Scott Myers was not present and did not have a written report for the Board.

New Business

NEHA Exam

- The Board reviewed the examination passage rates for 2015.
 - After reviewing the material that Ms. Youst had put together for the candidates who had taken the exam so far this year, the Board determined that the degree the individual held did not appear to be the issue surrounding the examination, as many test takers and employers had previously indicated.
 - The Board is still under the assumption that a lack of proper preparation on the part of the examination takers is what is responsible for the low passage rate.
 - Keith Krinn informed the Board that he had spoken to NEHA regarding the national passage rate for the past several years to compare to our passage rate.
 - Ohio does require a higher passing point; however, the national passage rate in 2013 was 23.1% and the Ohio passage rate in 31.6%. In 2014, the national passage rate was 30.9% and in Ohio the passage rate was 41.5%. For 2015, thus far, the national passage rate was at 54.5%, while Ohio's passage rate was 34%.
- The Examination Committee, consisting of James Adams, Chuck Hart and Keith Krinn, will work on developing a report for the Board regarding the NEHA examination.

2016 Rule Review

- Ms. Youst informed the Board that there are several rules up for five year review in 2016. An email will be sent to the listserv seeking comment prior to the November 18 Board meeting so that the rules can be discussed at that time.





Overview of Activities since the July 29, 2015 Board Meeting

- Reviewed applications for registration and continuing education credit.
- On August 3, 2015 the Board went live with the first phase of the eLicensing 3.0 upgrade that included RS registrants only.
 - A letter was sent to all active registrants dated July 30, 2015 that informed them of the change to the new system and asked them to register on the new site with the information provided in the letter.
- August 6 and 12, 2015 met with DAS OIT regarding the eLicensing 3.0 system design and data conversion to discuss lessons learned during the first portion of the conversion and to discuss FAQ's for the eLicensing website.
- August 17-19, 2015, August 24, 26-27, 2015, September 10-11, 2015, and September 14-15, 2015 met with the Deloitte team and DAS OIT to develop the next phase of the eLicensing 3.0 system which will include SIT's and training agencies.
- Attended an overview of the new union contract on September 2, 2015.
- Attended Boards and Commissions Management Group meetings on August 27, 2015.
