With the passage of the Budget Bill (Sub. H.B. 49), the Ohio Board of Sanitarian Registration will be abolished and all duties and governing authority will be transferred to the Ohio Department of Health and the Board will become an advisory committee to the Director of the Ohio Department of Health. This change, pursuant to the passage of Sub. H.B. 49, will take place within 90 days of the effective date of the legislation, which is expected to be July 1, 2017.

What that means for those of you who are registered with the Board as sanitarians and sanitarians-in-training is that nothing will change. You will still be responsible for renewing your registration and completing your continuing education. You may contact the office if you have questions regarding practice issues or licensure questions. The licensure system and way you submit your continuing education requests will be effective for the time being.

This is all the information the Board has available at this time. When we receive further guidance from the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, the Office of Budget and Management and the Ohio Department of Health, we will forward it on to you. We expect this transition to be fully effective by October 30, 2017.
